

Appropriate Insignia with personal Arms to be shown by the Roman Catholic Clergy

Whereas it hath been represented unto me that the prelates and other clergy of the Roman Catholic Church have customarily used insignia in connection with their personal Armorial Bearings, but that such insignia is not at present recorded in the College of Arms And that whereas it now seems expedient that when granting personal Armorial Ensigns to prelates and other clergy of the Roman Catholic Church the appropriate insignia may be shown with their Arms I, Bernard Marmaduke, Duke of Norfolk, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Victorian Order, Earl Marshal and Hereditary Marshal of England and One of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, do hereby authorize and require you to record these Presents and the annexed schedule detailing the insignia abovementioned accordingly and for so doing this shall be your Warrant Given under my hand and Seal this 17th day of July 1967
